\*Tiebreakers are determined by head to head record first and then by total of lowest amount of runs scored against (based on the teams tied).

\*Top two seeded teams in each division will have a first round bye.

\*Home team is determined by lower seed ranking.

\*First choice for field of play is field of home team, if home team field is not available, then visitors reserve the right to use their field, however home team retains home team status.

\*Cost of Umpires are split by each team 50/50

\*Rainouts are scheduled for the following day.

\*Because all-stars were moved up 1 week and we extended the season 1 week, the Championship game will have to be played after all-stars.

\*Regarding the Minimum 6 game rule, that rule was based on the fact the everyone would be playing 14 or 15 games and if a player played 6 games they would have at least 40% playing time (pretty generous, considering all-stars is 60%). With that being said, and because we do not want to penalize the kids for unplayed make-up games, a player must play at least 6 games or have played at least 40% of the total games played, this refers to Juniors playoffs only.

Seeding is determined by.

1. Win Average
2. Head to head record
3. Average of fewest runs scored against (based on the two teams that are tied)

Playoff schedule will be as follows:

Play-In Game Saturday June 19th. American League - Last two teams in the American Division will play to determine #6 seed.

Round 1 Monday June 21st. Both Divisions - #3 seed vs. #6 seed and #4 seed vs. #5 seed

Round 2 Wednesday June 23rd. Both Divisions - #1 seed vs. lower seeded winner of Round 1 and #2 seed vs. higher seeded winner of Round 1 in each division.

Round 3 Friday June 25th. Both Divisions - Two winners of Round 2 play each other to determine divisional winner for each division.

Championship Game TBD - American Division Winner of Round 3 vs. National Division Winner of Round 3.
